DOMAINE HERESZTYN-MAZZINI

Julia: This is the second vintage for Florence Heresztyn-Mazzini, who runs the estate with her husband Simon. They gave a large proportion of old vines. The wines were assembled into tank straight after the 2014 harvest, and will be bottled in March.

<u>Dom Heresztyn-Mazzini, Clos Village 2013 Gevrey-Chambertin</u> 15.5 Drink 2017-2022 Soft light red. Very stemmy on the nose and also on the palate. Fresh but a bit austere on the palate, though there is a softness to the tannins on the finish. (JH)

<u>Dom Heresztyn-Mazzini, Vieilles Vignes 2013 Gevrey-Chambertin</u> 16 Drink 2017-2022 Mid to deep cherry red. Aroma of sweet red damsons and a touch of cedar. Not as sweet on the palate, a little spicy. Dry, tight, modest but harmonious. (JH)

<u>Dom Heresztyn-Mazzini, Les Milandes Premier Cru 2013 Morey-St-Denis</u> 16 Drink 2017-2021

Mid cherry. Lovely ripe fruit on the nose without a hint of overripeness. Soft, rounded, not terribly long – tails off a bit on the finish. (JH)

Dom Heresztyn-Mazzini, Les Goulots Premier Cru 2013 Gevrey-Chambertin 16 Drink 2016-2020

A little lighter colour than the Gevrey La Perrière but equally dark fruited, more peppery. The texture is distinctive here, creamy-smooth and the tannins very much in the background. Not quite the same depth of fruit as in La Perrière. More approachable. (JH)

<u>Dom Heresztyn-Mazzini, La Perrière Premier Cru 2013 Gevrey-Chambertin</u> 16.5 Drink 2018-2023

Mid crimson. Inviting dark, ripe yet fresh cherry fruit. Firmer than I expected on the palate but a definite Gevrey character – fine-grained dryish tannins are wrapped up in dark not-yet-expressive fruit. (JH)

<u>Dom Heresztyn-Mazzini, Grand Cru 2013 Clos-St-Denis</u> 16+ Drink 2018-2022 Deepish cherry red. Light roasted aroma, peperry too but red fruit emerges in the glass. Perfectly pleasant but doesn't really have grand cru excitement or intensity. (JH)
