

## DOMAINE HERESZTYN-MAZZINI, Gevrey Chambertin

RH: In the upper ranges, these wines can't be called value for money, but that's hardly unusual for burgundy!

- Dom Heresztyn-Mazzini, Vieilles Vignes 2016 Gevrey-Chambertin Closed and unyielding on the nose and palate. Compact, black-cherry fruit but fairly light body and only modest spiciness on the finish. Certainly on the lighter side of Gevrey. (RH) Drink 2020-2032

- Dom Heresztyn-Mazzini, Clos Village 2016 Gevrey-Chambertin Much more interest and expressiveness on the nose than their Vieilles Vignes, with herby notes as well as redcurrant and raspberry. Characterful and spicy on the palate. Fine tannic grain gives a light outline to the finish. (RH) Drink 2021-2041

- Dom Heresztyn-Mazzini, Les Songes 2016 Gevrey-Chambertin Beetroot and cranberry - a very savoury style of fruit, as befits Gevrey. Rounded tannins with well-integrated acidic tang on the finish. (RH) Drink 2020-2036

- Dom Heresztyn-Mazzini, La Perrière Premier Cru 2016 Gevrey-Chambertin Restrained and boxy with firm tannic chew and medium body. One of those confusing premiers crus that seems less impressive than their 'lesser' wines - but presumably, complexity will hatch from this egg. (RH) Drink 2021-2041

- Dom Heresztyn-Mazzini, Les Goulots Premier Cru 2016 Gevrey-Chambertin *50% whole-bunch fermentation.*  
Redcurrant and cranberry giving a tart but enjoyable fruit style. The palate has an austere edge - not over-tannic, but quite reedy and unfleshy. (RH) Drink 2020-2034

- Dom Heresztyn-Mazzini, Champonnet Premier Cru 2016 Gevrey-Chambertin *70% whole-bunch fermentation.*  
Lots of tannic fuzz and concentration - has all the heft that seems missing from their Goulots. Emphatic acidic crispness to finish, with a slight floral aftertaste. (RH) Drink 2023-2041

- Dom Heresztyn-Mazzini, Les Milandes Premier Cru 2016 Morey-St-Denis Understated nose and restrained palate. The sort of wine that make people find burgundy underwhelming, I fear. Just not really enough of anything for this price. (RH) Drink 2020-2030

- Dom Heresztyn-Mazzini, Grand Cru 2016 Clos St-Denis Very firm and husky on the palate. Ripe but conservative fruit character. Impressive core concentration, which will unfurl for sure. (RH) Drink 2022-2041
