This domaine may be located in Gevrey-Chambertin, but its only grand cru - a 40-year-old 0.23ha parcelis in neighbouring Morey-St-Denis. The proportion of whole bunches is the highest ever at 70% in 2017, continuing a shift in style. This is quite a ripe wine, but has plenty of supporting tannin, spice and oak, with some chalky minerality adding extra complexity.

This is quite a serious, well-structured premier cru from Florence Heresztyn and Simon Mazzini, sourced from a 66-year-old parcel that's often used for the domaine's massal selections. Dense, rich and textured, it shows some ripe blueberry jam notes, a hint of sap from whole bunches, and well-handled 35% new wood.



Always a great value wine, the domaine's village red is an old-vine cuvée from two lieux-dits - En Songe and Les Gueulepines - both of which are on the northern side of village. With 60% whole bunches and 30% new wood, it's an ambitious Gevrey, showing good density and weight, fine tannins and supporting acidity.
