



The domaine is now certified ECOCERT, in addition to which they continue with some plant therapy remedies, and are moving towards using a cover crop between the rows which then gets rolled in, to avoid ploughing. Picking began on 18th September with average yields of 34 hl/ha, and degrees similar to 2018, though with nothing above 13.8%. There were no reported fermentation issues. Another range of fine wines from Florence and Simon Heresztyn-Mazzini.

Red

2019, Bourgogne Pinot Noir, Domaine Heresztyn-Mazzini ★ ★ ★ ★ 86-87

All destemmed, no new wood. Light to medium crimson, with a plummy fruit, that follows on the nose. Rather easy-going on the palate, but generous. Just enough acidity. Tasted: November 2020

2019, Gevrey-Chambertin Clos Village, Domaine Heresztyn-Mazzini ★ ★ ★ ★ 89-91

50% stems, light fresh and stylish, mid red to crimson, light strawberry notes, a little dry patch here from the stems, though that will go away in time, sweet fruit perfume following through. Tasted: November 2020

2019, Chambolle-Musigny, Domaine Heresztyn-Mazzini ★ ★ ★ ★ 90-92

From Bas Doix and Echanges, 60% whole bunch, vinified with a light hand - hardly any punching down here. Rather deeper crimson. Here the whole bunch is better integrated with the fruit. Very attractive, clean raspberry fruit, some elegance, not over ripe though the fruit is moving towards some blacker notes. The little youthful bitterness of stems, elegant and long. Tasted: November 2020

2019, Gevrey-Chambertin Vieilles Vignes, Domaine Heresztyn-Mazzini ★ ★ ★ ★ 90-93

From vines in Pincevin, Es Murots and Puits de la Baraque, 65 years and above. 50% whole bunch. 25% to 30% new wood, as for all village wines. Mid purple colour with an exuberant bouncing deep raspberry fruit. There is generous dark fruit in the mouth, filling out the back of the palate and hiding the stems. Tasted: November 2020

2019, Gevrey-Chambertin Vieilles Vignes Cuvée Les Jouises, Domaine Heresztyn-Mazzini ★ ★ ★ ★ 91-93

From Les Jouises and Fourneaux, with 55% stems. Glowing purple, the liveliest colour so far. The fresh but ripe dark raspberry content shows further on the nose too. Much more backward, firm tannins but covered by the generosity of the fruit. A Gevrey to lay down for longer. Upright in stature! Tasted: November 2020

2019, Gevrey-Chambertin Vieilles Vignes Cuvée Les Songes, Domaine Heresztyn-Mazzini ★ ★ ★ ★ 91-93

From En Song and Les Guelepines. One plot dates back to 1926. This cuvée enjoys 100% whole bunches and 30% new wood. Rich crimson to purple colour. A great density of fruit here with the stems opening out the structure. Less dense luxury style than Jouises, but still with excellent structure for the long term and an attractive long finish. Tasted: November 2020

2019, Gevrey-Chambertin La Perrière 1er Cru, Domaine Heresztyn-Mazzini ★ ★ ★ ★ 90-93

Darker fruit, 50% whole bunch, one third new wood which is standard for the Heresztyn 1ers crus. More crimson than purple. Fine even red purple, a little spice at the back, maybe a touch meaty too, good weight a medium bodied Gevrey with some persistence. Tasted: November 2020

2019, Gevrey-Chambertin Les Goulots 1er Cru, Domaine Heresztyn-Mazzini ★ ★ ★ ★ 92-94

50% whole bunch, one third new wood But they do play between tonneliers and chauffes. Medium deep crimson-purple, Good fruit weight here, a delicious balanced and long finish, this is supple yet with proper concentration. Always a lovely cuvee here and this year no mistake. A cool site which does not suffer from the warmer years. Delicious detailed yet discreet aromatics. Tasted: November 2020

2019, Gevrey-Chambertin Les Champonnets 1er Cru, Domaine Heresztyn-Mazzini ★ ★ ★ ★ 92-95

Delicious gorgeous purple. 100% whole bunch but smothered by the fruit. A balanced headiness if you like, and beautifully attractive. The stems add a little structure, almost some muscle to the back, which I think is valuable in these richer years. Tasted: November 2020

2019, Morey-St-Denis Les Millandes 1er Cru, Domaine Heresztyn-Mazzini ★ ★ ★ ★ 90-92

100% whole bunch. Yields were better in Morey after some August rain. Purple with a dark centre. There is a powerful dense concentration of dark fruit on the nose. A lifted very ripe dark strawberry nose, possibly verging on the cooked, soft sweetness on the palate, and with firmer tannins. 70 year old vines which are showing a touch too much ripeness, characteristic of this site. Small millerand grapes. Tasted: November 2020

2019, Clos St-Denis Grand Cru, Domaine Heresztyn-Mazzini ★ ★ ★ ★ 94-96

Located next to the Ponsot winery. 100% whole bunch, 50% new wood. Fine deep crimson-purple. The hedonism of Clos St-Denis is a little bit tamed by the whole bunches which add a thread of structure running all through the middle. Will that dissipate and let the wine express itself fully? I think so, but not straight away. There is no faulting the fruit concentration, and the tightly wound structure at the back holds good promise for the future. Very nicely balanced.
