

2020 Bourgogne Pinot Noir	16	Cask sample. Perfumed. Violets. Nice freshness and good texture here. Good depth but pricy for Bourgogne Rouge. (AWH)
2020 Gevrey-Chambertin Vieilles Vignes	16.5	Cask sample. Fine tannins. Typical earthiness of Gevrey. Crisp dark fruit. Elegant and textured. A classy village Gevrey. (AWH)
2020 Gevrey-Chambertin Les Songes Vieilles Vignes	17	Cask sample. Spicy, red/black fruit. Good freshness. Elegant tannins. Not a blockbuster. Sweet fruit and good length. A very classy Gevrey. (AWH)
2020 Chambolle-Musigny	16	Cask sample. Lighter. Elegant. Perhaps lacks a little depth and complexity at this price but is a fine Chambolle nevertheless. (AWH)
2020 Morey-St-Denis 1er Cru Les Millandes	16	Cask sample. Intense. Weighty palate. Crisp and dense. Dark-fruit character. A little dry on the finish. Typical earthy, meaty Morey. But still retains finesse and elegance. (AWH)
2020 Gevrey-Chambertin 1er Cru Les Goulots	16.5	Cask sample. Gentle red fruit on the palate. Subtle and fine. Sweetness of fruit. Lots of finesse. Nice oak. Not a blockbuster. Not great value perhaps but there is class here. (AWH)
2020 Gevrey-Chambertin 1er Cru La Perrière	17+	Cask sample. Big step up in depth and heft. Dark-fruit character. But still manages to be a very elegant and refined premier cru. Plenty of wood but the density of the wine can take this. Drink now or keep for many years. (AWH)
2020 Gevrey-Chambertin 1er Cru Champonnets	16.5	Cask sample. Clean, fresh, lively. Fine tannins. Very precise, not so obviously premier cru with the first taste but the longer the wine spends in the glass, the more it evolves and shows its class. Long, lingering and fine. (AWH)
2020 Clos St-Denis Grand Cru	17.5+	Cask sample. Deep, dark, dense and briary. Lovely purity of fruit. Sweet. Great balance of oak and acidity. Long future. (AWH)
