A clear dense purple. Very dark fruit, quite dense. Indeed, very intense, a dark bramble and blackcurrant fruit without suggesting reduction. In common with other wines in this flight there is a dry element but I don't think that the wine will evolve negatively. Liquorice notes at the back. Ardeaseal closure. Drink from 2030.

2018, Gevrey-Chambertin Les Goulots 1er Cru, Domaine Heresztyn-Mazzini

Brisk deep crimson red. Plenty of energy on the nose, in quite a savoury style, plums and soft red fruit too. Plenty of volume on the palate as well, now showing more of the strawberry character which I associate with this part of Gevrey. Not a monumental wine, but well balanced within the context of the vintage. Just a little spice at the finish as part of a delicious and complex aftertaste. Ready relatively soon. Ardeaseal closure. Drink from 2026. Tasted: September 2022
