

2022, Gevrey-Chambertin Les Goulots 1er Cru, Domaine Heresztyn-Mazzini

★★★★☆ 91-93

50% whole bunch vinification. Medium crimson, a floral bouquet with ripe red currants as well. Then some savoury red fruit notes, a little orange rind, quite tannic at the back, less juicy than Perrière but holds its own very nicely. Drink from 2030-2037. Tasted: November 2023.

2022, Gevrey-Chambertin La Perrière 1er Cru, Domaine Heresztyn-Mazzini

★★★★☆ 91-94

Mid crimson. Quite an elegant nose, floral rose notes, 50% whole bunch vinification, as well as some graceful red fruit. The oak is a little present at the finish but that will integrate and the fruit is very classy, finesse and some tensile strength, but nothing too powerful. A good juicy aftertaste. Drink from 2030-2037. Tasted: November 2023.

2022, Gevrey-Chambertin Vieilles Vignes Cuvée Les Songes, Domaine Heresztyn-Mazzini

★★★★☆ 90-93

80-90% whole bunch vinification. Medium deep crimson. Some density of ripe raspberry on the nose, and I am happy that I don't see the hail effect though this sector was hit. Instead, Les Songes has a pretty concentrated dark red fruit with a seductive finish where the fruit is stronger than the tannic structure. Drink from 2030-2037. Tasted: November 2023.

2022, Gevrey-Chambertin Vieilles Vignes Cuvée Les Jouises, Domaine Heresztyn-Mazzini

★★★★☆ 90-93

The Jouises cuvée has a darker crimson ruby colour. Perhaps a touch of pepper but the stems do not infiltrate too much on the nose. Quite intense in raspberry fruit but with drier tannins, not quite harmonious yet. Raspberry with redcurrant. 70% whole bunch vinification. Drink from 2030-2037. Tasted: November 2023.

2022, Morey-St-Denis Les Millandes 1er Cru, Domaine Heresztyn-Mazzini

★★★★☆ 92-94

80% whole bunch vinification. Medium deep crimson ruby. The bouquet is attractive but without too much detail yet. There is a dense concentration of a fresh red berry fruit, plenty in mid palate then a slightly gentler finish. Overall, though, Les Millandes is coherent and in the style of the vintage. Not one of the wilder Moreys but well put together. Drink from 2031-2038. Tasted: November 2023.

2022, Clos St-Denis Grand Cru, Domaine Heresztyn-Mazzini

★★★★☆ 94-97

A fine bright purple. The nose is solid and concentrated, in a forward style of raspberry fruit. There is a wealth of fruit on the palate though not as seductive as Clos St-Denis can be, but all in balance and with an agreeably long finish. A really sensible, poised, approach to winemaking. 80% whole bunch vinification hardly shows, while 50% new oak feels about right. Drink from 2032-2040. Tasted: November 2023.

2022, Gevrey-Chambertin Les Champonnets 1er Cru, Domaine Heresztyn-Mazzini

★★★★☆ 93-95

A fine deep purple, with a little white pepper infiltrating the fully laden raspberry fruit on the nose. A delightfully concentrated fruit on the palate, still with some tannins at the back and the drier style of finish from whole bunches. But all this is beginning to integrate nicely to make a stylish and complete wine. 80-90% whole bunches. Drink from 2031-2038. Tasted: November 2023.

2022, Gevrey-Chambertin Vieilles Vignes, Domaine Heresztyn-Mazzini

★★★★★ 90-92

Various plots throughout. 50% whole bunch vinification. Interestingly this seems to have a lighter colour than the Clos Village despite being evidently a wine of greater body and concentration. The nose hovers between raspberry and strawberry, with a fresher finish. Medium length, though classy. Drink from 2030-2037. Tasted: November 2023.

2022, Gevrey-Chambertin Clos Village, Domaine Heresztyn-Mazzini

★★★★★ 89-92

Dark crimson purple, with a soft fruit on the nose. More strawberry on the palate, quite light but also refined, continues across the middle to a gentler finish. In the end quite persistent, but this is not, nor ever can be, a full-bodied Gevrey. 50% whole bunch vinification. Drink from 2027-2031. Tasted: November 2023.

2022, Chambolle-Musigny, Domaine Heresztyn-Mazzini

★★★★★ 89-91

60% whole bunch vinification. A pretty crimson colour. An engaging soft red fruit with a floral overtone, quite discreet. The fruit has a dry finish perhaps from the barrel, just lacks a little concentration through the middle. Drink from 2027-2031. Tasted: November 2023.

2022, Côte de Nuits-Villages Queue de Hareng, Domaine Heresztyn-Mazzini

★★★★★ 89-91

A new cuvée, made with 50% whole bunches, the last to be picked, and yielding just 18 hl/ha. Raspberry with a redcurrant edge, quite gentle fruit but with intensity. A long and powerful finish. Drink from 2026-2030. Tasted: November 2023.

2022, Bourgogne Pinot Noir Champ Franc, Domaine Heresztyn-Mazzini

★★★★★ 86-88

Bright mid purple. Fresh red fruit, ripe enough but also savoury, attractive acidity and length. A pretty strawberry fruit with a touch of redcurrant. This will be bottled in December. Drink from 2025-2028. Tasted: November 2023.
